Respective Functions of the Board of Governors and the Principal in relation to admissions.

The Board of Governors have delegated to an Admissions Sub-Committee the task of selecting pupils for admission. The Sub-committee consists of the Principal and three other Governors.

Children who are not normally resident in Northern Ireland at the time of proposed admission will not be considered for places until all children who reside in Northern Ireland have been considered.

The Board of Governors has determined that, in the event of more applicants than places available, the following Admissions Criteria will be applied, in the order set down, to select children for the available places.

Admissions Criteria

A timetable of pre-school admissions procedures setting out the dates by which an application is to be submitted is available at www.eani.org.uk/admissions under 'Pre-School Admissions'. During the admissions procedure when applying the criteria punctual applications will be considered before late applications are considered.

The application procedure opens on 7 January 2021 at 12noon (GMT) and an application submitted by the closing date of 29 January 2021 at 12noon (GMT) will be treated as a <u>punctual application</u>. An application received after 12noon (GMT) on 29 January 2021 will be treated as a <u>late application</u>.

As the pre-school admissions procedure is in two stages the timetable also specifies the relevant dates at Stage 2 which will determine if an application is to be considered as punctual or late.

Statutory Criteria

- 1 Children from socially disadvantaged circumstances born between 2 July 2017 and 1 July 2018.
- 2 Children born between 2 July 2017 and 1 July 2018.

Note: Children from 'socially disadvantaged circumstances' means a child whose parent is in receipt of (i) Income Support, or (ii) Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, or (iii) an award of Income Support which has been converted into an Employment and Support Allowance and the level of benefit remains the same, or (iv) Universal Credit. When parents apply for places for their child on this basis they must provide Benefit Verification to confirm that they are in receipt of a qualifying payment. This should be provided to the Pre-School of first preference and the application procedure for Pre-School will outline how this can be submitted.

Non Statutory Criteria

3 Children born between 2 July 2018 and 1 July 2019. (Places will be allocated on the basis of age i.e. oldest first). In the event of two or more identical dates of birth, selection will be made using the random alphabetical tie-breaker as listed below.

Sub-Criteria

In the event of more pupils satisfying the last statutory criterion which can be applied in the order of priority set down above then selection for the remaining places will be on the basis of the following sub-criteria.

- (a) Children who list St Conor's Nursery Unit as their first preference.
- (b) Children with brother/sister(s)/half-brother/half-sister(s)/brother/step-brother/step-sister(s)/adopted brother/sister(s), foster brother/sister(s) enrolled in St Conor's Primary School or Nursery Unit on 1 September 2021.
- (c) Children who are the first child in the family.

In the event of over-subscription in the last criterion which can be applied, then selection for all places remaining in this category will be on the basis of the initial letter of the surname as per the birth certificate, in the order set out below:

Mc E C S M D P L G O U N J H Mac B T Y F K R A X Z W V I Q

The order was determined by a randomised selection of letters of the alphabet. In the event of surnames beginning with the same letter the subsequent letters of the surnames will be used in alphabetical order. In the event of two identical surnames the alphabetical order of the initials of the forenames as per the birth certificate will be used.

It is important that parent(s)/guardian(s) when submitting the application form give all the relevant supporting information and written evidence that may be needed including the child's birth certificate. If a place is offered on the basis of incorrect or misleading information, then the Board of Governors may withdraw the offer.

If parents/guardians have any difficulty in completing the application form, then they should consult the Principal of the school.

Applications after 1 September 2021

The same criteria will be used for part-time admission after 1 September 2021.

Duty to Verify

The Board of Governors reserves the right to require such supplementary evidence as it may determine to support or verify information on any application form.

If the requested evidence is not provided to the Board of Governors by the deadline given, this will result in the withdrawal of an offer of a place. Similarly, if information is supplied which appears to be false or misleading in any material way, the offer of a place will be withdrawn.

Waiting List Policy

Should a vacancy arise after Wednesday 9 June 2021 all applications for admission to Nursery that were initially refused, new applications, late applications and applications where new information has been provided will be treated equally and the published criteria applied. This waiting list will be in place until 30 June 2022. The school will contact you in writing if your child gains a place in the school by this method. Your child's name will be automatically added to the list. Please contact the school if you wish your child's name to be removed from the list.

Parents/Guardians should also note that if their child is seeking nursery provision for the 2^{nd} year they MUST reapply.
